1. AQIS FUMIGATION CONTAINERS

From 18 November all containers requiring fumigation will no longer be tailgated at Cargo Distributors. This new AQIS monitoring fee will now be the responsibility of the fumigator and as a result, AQIS will stop charging the \$80.00 entry fee.

Carriers, however will be imposing an additional charge of \$60-\$70 per 20/40 container to cover the additional costs of fumigating containers at their depots but will no longer be charging Tailgate fees,

2. WEST COAST USA - DOCK STRIKE OVER

An agreement has finally been reached that will see a new six-year contract being put into place. Delays which have disrupted oceanfreight world-wide are slowly being rectified and we hope to see all back on track soon.
