

North East Asia to Australia
General rate increase

Dear Valued Customer,

Please note that Maersk Line, in association with the Asia Australia Discussion Agreement (AADA), will be implementing a General Rate Increase (GRI) for cargo from Korea, China, Hong Kong and Taiwan to Australia, effective 01 July 2006.

From 01 July 2006 all outward shipments originating in China, Hong Kong and Taiwan to ports and points in Australia will levy an increase of USD 350/TEU for both dry and refrigerated cargo in the base ocean freight.

From 01 July 2006 all outward shipments with origin in Korea to ports and points in Australia will levy an increase of USD 300/TEU for both dry and refrigerated cargo in the base ocean freight.

This increase will apply in full on top of existing ongoing market rates and will be subject to accessorial surcharges applicable at the time of shipment.
