From July 2007, Shanghai Customs have instituted a new policy relating to random inspections. Such inspections will henceforth take place on the day after the notice day. To ensure securing both LCL and FCL shipments on scheduled vessels, we cannot jeopardise the movement of containers by awaiting late shipments. Such late shipments will be automatically held until the next sailing. We will of course always inform you of the updated loading situation. Please refer to the below attached "CUT OFF TIME SCHEDULE" form for all shipments. Please ensure your suppliers are aware of the need to follow these cut-offs to give your cargo the best chance of meeting intended vessel sailings.
