Notifications have been received advising of increased fees on AQIS entries and inspections. AQIS revised fee packages are being introduced to ensure adequate biosecurity services can be maintained and to also allow improved quarantine practices to benefit both industry and the Australian public. The revised fee structure covers a variety of changes, the simplification of some charges, and the alignment of similar fees from other AQIS programmes.
