There's yet another tropical storm brewing over the Pacific Ocean and it is forecast to negatively impact Shanghai Sunday night or early Monday morning.

The storm is expected to strengthen into a Category 1 typhoon before making landfall on Japan's Ryukyu Islands on Saturday. It is expected the storm cell will then veer northwest toward China's east coast. As of now, Shanghai is in the storm's direct path.

The typhoon may effect shipping schedules if berthing delays or berth departures are activated during the storm phase.
